To establish care at CommunityHealth you will need to meet the following guidelines:

- Be uninsured, except for those who have Medicare Part A ONLY (must provide care)
- Provide proof of income (must be at or below 250% Federal Poverty Guidelines)
- Choose CommunityHealth as your primary care provider
- Be ineligible for government sponsored insurance programs

Please bring the following information with you at the time of registration:

1. Proof of address (Note: we do NOT accept PO boxes)
2. Picture ID
3. List of current medications (if applicable)
4. Copy of all medical records (if you have been seen by a physician within the last three years)
5. Letter of termination from insurance company, if applicable
6. Proof of income (see below)
 - Patients who file taxes:
 - Tax returns from the previous year
 - Patients who DO NOT file taxes:
 - Check stubs from the last 30 days, or
 - Written statement from employer (must be on employer stationary), or
 - If you are supported by someone else, we will need their proof of income (e.g. tax returns, check stubs, or letter on employer stationary)

Please note that a doctor will not be able to see you at the time of registration. Upon successfully completing the registration process, an appointment will be scheduled. **CommunityHealth is NOT a walk in clinic.**

Intake hours:

Monday: 9 am -1 pm

Tuesday: 10 am-4 pm

Wednesday: 9 am-12 pm

Thursday: 9 am-12 pm

Friday: 9 am-2 pm

Clinic hours:

Monday and Wednesday only, 1-4 pm

Note: Cook County (John Stroger Hospital) serves residents of Cook County only. If you are not a Cook County resident, you may go to the nearest emergency room in your area.
