

## Understanding Your Insurance

Health4Chicago is an in-school immunization program for children and adolescents, providing vaccines recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and the American Academy of Pediatrics. Any child uninsured or covered by Medicaid will get free vaccines from the Vaccines for Children program. For those not eligible, your insurance will be billed just like at your doctor's office.

**If you have private insurance, we encourage you to call and verify your insurance coverage prior to your school's Health4Chicago immunization clinic.** Please call the customer service number on the back of your insurance card. Here is some helpful information:

**Ask:** What is the benefit (what your policy covers) for immunizations administered at a school (Billing Site 03)? These are outpatient, preventative services.
