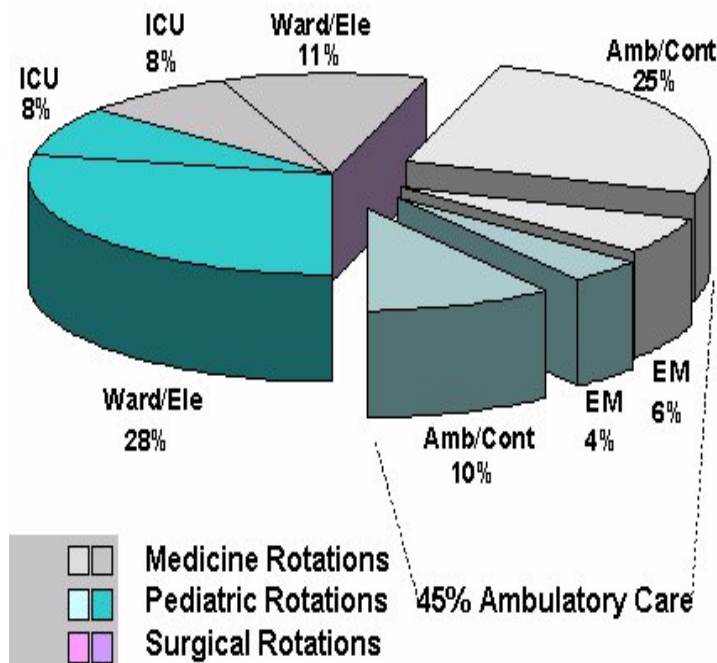
Med-Peds

 - 2 years of training instead of 3

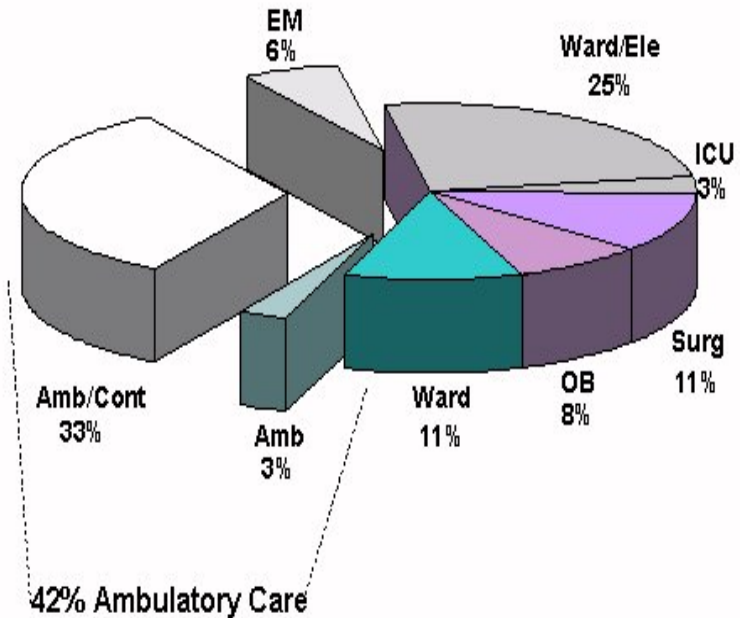

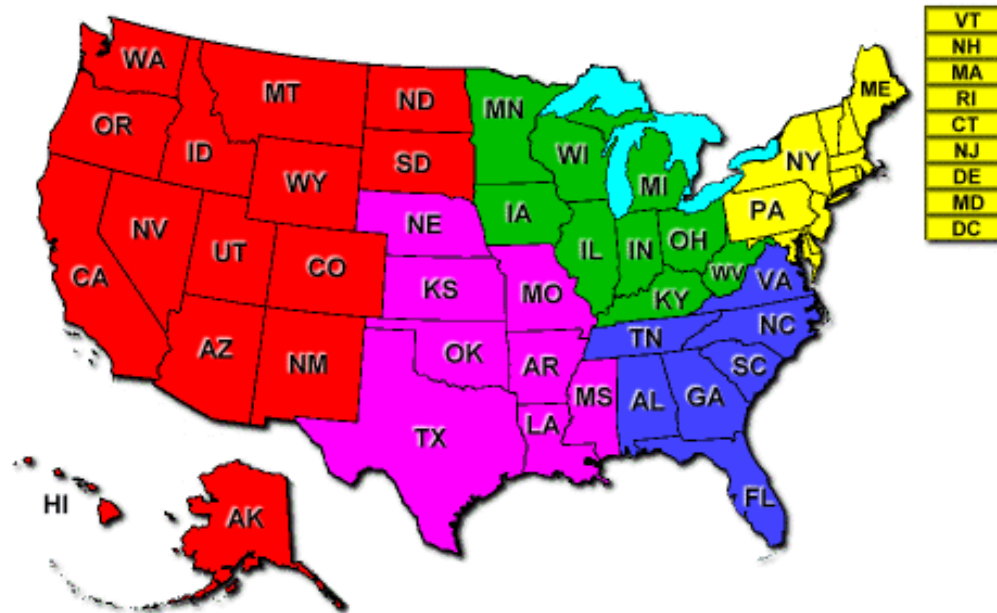
